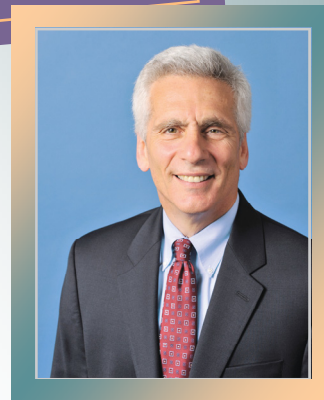

### *Elections 2012: The Good, the Bad and the Ugly from an Economist's Perspective*



Jared Bernstein

Nationally known economist Jared Bernstein will share his perspective on the election results and their impact on economic and fiscal policy. Bernstein joined the Center on Budget and Policy Priorities in May 2011 as a Senior Fellow. From 2009 to 2011, Bernstein was the Chief Economist and Economic Adviser to Vice President Joe Biden, executive director of the White House Task Force on the Middle Class, and a member of President Obama's economic team.

Bernstein is the author and coauthor of numerous books for both popular and academic audiences, including *Crunch: Why Do I Feel So Squeezed?* and nine editions of *The State of Working America*. Bernstein has published extensively in various venues, including *The New York Times*, *Washington Post*, *Financial Times*, and *Research in Economics and Statistics*. He is an on-air commentator for the cable stations CNBC and MSNBC and hosts [jaredbernsteinblog.com](http://jaredbernsteinblog.com).
